1) Proposed Rule Amendments

On March 16, 2022, the Commission issued an order opening working Case No. GW-2022-0327 to consider amending the Commission's natural gas safety rules. PHMSA provided the MO PSC a copy of information it sent to municipality and community owned natural gas operators on March 15, 2022. The information pertains to grant funding that will be made available to municipality or community owned utilities (not including for-profit entities) to repair, rehabilitate, or replace natural gas distribution pipelines, or portions thereof, or to acquire equipment to reduce incidents and fatalities, and to avoid economic loss.
