PHMSA Annual Report for Natural Gas Transmission

- 1. PHMSA conducted a webinar today to discuss changes to the annual report for calendar year 2010 for natural gas transmission and gathering systems. The latest draft forms, instructions and slides from the webinar will be posted to the MANGO website. You may also contact us for copies via email.
- 2. Important date changes:
 - a. The new filing deadline is August 15, 2011.
 - b. The new anticipated date that the on-line reporting will be available through the PHMSA portal is June 15, 2011.

PHMSA advisory bulletin regarding MAOP

PHMSA has issued an Advisory Bulletin to remind operators of gas and hazardous liquid pipeline facilities of their responsibilities, under Federal integrity management (IM) regulations, to perform detailed threat and risk analyses that integrate accurate data and information from their entire pipeline system, especially when calculating Maximum Allowable Operating Pressure (MAOP) or Maximum Operating Pressure (MOP), and to utilize these risk analyses in the identification of appropriate assessment methods, and preventative and mitigative measures.
